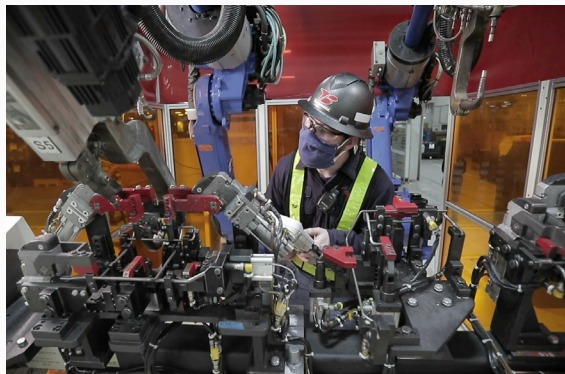


# Students, your time is now!



## THE ADVANCED MANUFACTURING TECHNICIAN PROGRAM (AMT)

is an exciting, two-year Associate Degree that combines cutting-edge curriculum with paid working experience. This program allows high school graduates to learn attractive, high-tech skills and then apply this understanding “on the job” at world-class manufacturers in the Southern Indiana area.



Students will attend classes at Vincennes University for three days per week, with eight or more hours of classroom instruction from highly qualified industry experts. Students then have the opportunity to apply this learning at sponsoring companies, earning a competitive wage. This approach not only provides a high-quality collegiate experience, but allows the student to receive **two full years of on the job experience** with a pay structure designed to cover the expenses of tuition, fees and some personal expenses\*.

## ARE YOU ELIGIBLE FOR THE AMT PROGRAM?

Seniors or graduates are eligible to apply for the program through the **Vincennes University** application process. Once accepted, participants are chosen based on:

- **Academic success (GPA and class rank).**
- **Math and English capability as measured through ACT/SAT or Accuplacer scores.** (College Algebra MATH 102 and English Composition ENG 101)
- **Commitment to remaining absolutely illegal drug-free.**

## ARE YOU A GOOD FIT FOR THE AMT PROGRAM?

Students that thrive in the AMT program are tech savvy, strong in math/science and have a natural curiosity about how things work. Other important traits include a strong work ethic, good time management skills and the ability learn in a high-paced environment. Participation in **Project Lead The Way (PLTW)** or **Career and Technical Education** programs is a plus, but not required.

## WHAT ARE THE COSTS?

The AMT two-year program is designed to offset the approximately **\$35,000** in tuition, housing and fees at **Vincennes University** with approximately **\$40,000** or more in wages from **AMT employers** during the two year program.

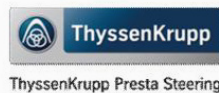
## WHEN & HOW SHOULD I APPLY?

Seniors in high school should apply at the **BEGINNING** of senior year (Do **NOT** wait until spring). Candidates should complete Vincennes application for admission, along with the Advanced Manufacturing Technician Program application form at [vinu.edu/amt](http://vinu.edu/amt).
